The remarkable patina boasts mill deposits with hints of purple, green, gold, yellow and black. Other characteristics include worm tracks, worm holes and rarely seen original circular saw marks. Recommended milling options (pictured) are butt-joinery with a micro-beveled edge.

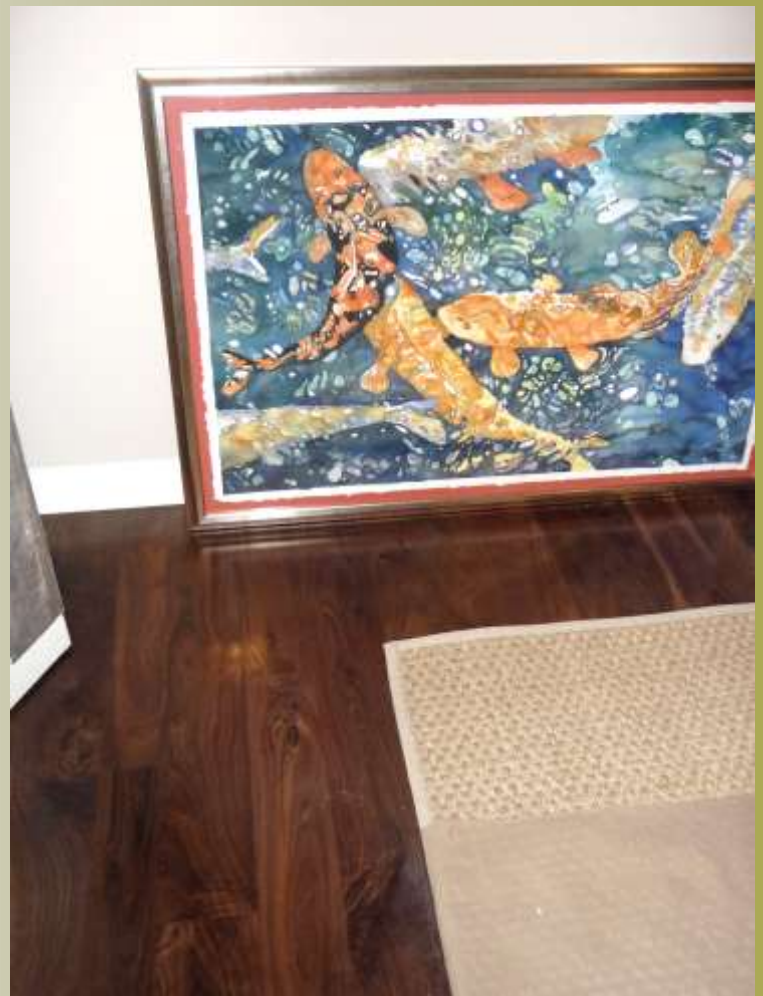
